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## Work, Health & Safety Policy

- Hold all people employed by Doito Pty Ltd accountable for their Work Health & Safety performance within their responsibility.
- Communicate openly with Workers, their representatives, the government and the community.
- Involve all Workers in the improvement of health and safety performance.
- Provide appropriate resources, information, training and development to promote Work Health & Safety improvement.
- Ensure contractors and visitors to Doito Pty Ltd are aware and comply with this policy.
- Co-operate with governments, industry and research bodies to continually improve the development of Work Health & Safety standards.

- Determining specific safety performance targets for all.

- Using teamwork and critique for problem identification and performance improvement.
